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DESTINY III


This Leopard 46 is a fast cruising, sailing catamaran built in South Africa by Robertson and Caine, and designed by Gino Morelli and Pete Melvin. She is a good looking cat with high, almost plumb bows streamlined to provide both cruising comfort and above average sailing speed.



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
Large open spaces are a great advantage of this yacht as the cockpit and saloon are made as a one-level area, creating a large living space. The galley is ideally positioned to use this open space -- and hardtop over the cockpit extends aft from the saloon roof providing both striking looks and a useful shaded covered area.

A fold-down platform is a nice addition aft of the cockpit, as it gives easy access to swimming or diving off the boat. When it is raised while underway, the platform creates a secure bench seat and barrier. A raised helm station with a separate hardtop allows full 360-degree views providing excellent visibility when sailing fast and navigating through the clear Bahamas waters.




Ideal for Six guests for overnight charters, or 12 guests on Daysail Trips

The layout includes three queen-bedded Guest Cabins, each with ensuite head with separate stall shower stalls and new electric flush toilets. All cabins, as well as the main saloon, are fully air conditioned. There is also a single berth accessible from the port forward guest cabin that can sleep 1 adult with additional deck access for privacy. With a 25ft. beam, Destiny III has a large and comfortable cockpit. Both inside and outside dining tables seat eight giving options of having meals inside or out.



Boat toys for your use include: 2 Standup Paddle Boards, Kayaks, Fishing Gear, 8 sets of Masks, Fins and Snorkels.

She is also equipped with new Black Carbon Fiber sails, new watermaker, 11.5 ft. Dinghy with new 20HP Yamaha 4 Stroke engine, 9 KW Generator, 2000 watt inverter, 5 AC units, and 750 watt Solar Panels and all new towels, linens & bedding.

Sample Menu

Breakfasts

~ Egg omelets with choice of Swiss, sharp cheddar, or feta cheeses, sautéed red onions, green peppers, and mushrooms, served with bacon and toasted English muffins

~ Fresh Bahamian Cinramon Bread French toast with sausage links or bacon

~ Croissant breakfast sandwiches with Brie cheese, soft scrambled eggs and ham, on a baked croissant, served with fresh fruit

~ Muffins, fresh fruit, yogurt and granola cereal

Lunches

~ Fresh caught blackened fish fingers or sandwich, served with salad and homemade balsamic vinaigrette dressing.

Rates for the 2018 season are all inclusive: All onboard meals, soft drinks, local beer, house wines, rum, vodka and mixers, fresh linens and towels, fuel, ice, snorkel equipment, paddle boards, and mooring fees.
